CAMP SITKA

Day Camps, overnight camping trips, and overnight boat trips for children.

Camp Sitka is located at Cascade Head Ranch between Neskowin and Lincoln City.

The idea behind the camp is to promote interest in and basic understanding of the sea and shoreline areas. We hope that close personal contact with these natural phenomena will help to build not only a scientific interest in biology but will also give the child a basis for aesthetic appreciation of our lovely coast environment.

Day Camp

Activities will include field trips to areas rich in the possibility of collecting limited amounts of sea flora and fauna. Their identification and preservation will be stressed. Emphasis will be placed upon close observation of sea life and its ecology.

Field trips for the purpose of watercolor painting will be made and materials from the beach will be used for small sculpture projects.

Trips will be devoted to conservative collecting of edible mollusks of the coast, where and when to find them, and their preparation of food.

The individual's responsibility for keeping the beaches unspoiled will be stressed.

Dates-- Session 1: July 21-24; Session 2: July 28-31; Session 3: August 4-7; Session 4: August 11-14.

Ages: 8-14. Maximum enrollment per session: 10 children. Fee: \$20.

Hours: 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. Child will need a sack lunch, coat and gloves.

Overnight Camping Trips

The trips will be devoted to camping, hiking, and exploring wild areas of Cascade Head. During these trips, attention will be given to observing the numerous natural attractions, including wildflowers and sea lions.

Dates-- Session 1: July 25-26; Session 2: August 1-2.

Ages: 9-14. Maximum enrollment per session: 7 children. Fee: \$15.

Hours: 10 a.m. Saturday to 2 p.m. Sunday. Meals will be provided. Child will need a sleeping bag and a raincoat.

Overnight Boat Trip

Activities will include rowing, swimming, camping, and exploration of the river banks of the Siletz River or the Nestucca River.

Dates-- August 8-9. Ages: 10-15. Maximum enrollment: 6 children. Fee: \$15.

Hours: 10 a.m. Saturday to 3 p.m. Sunday. Meals will be provided. Child will need a sleeping bag and a raincoat.

All sessions will be conducted by Frank and Jane Boyden. Frank Boyden is an Oregon artist who teaches in the art department at the University of New Mexico. He formerly taught at Tuft School, Connecticut. He has guided numerous boat trips on the rivers of Oregon and Idaho. Frank received a B.A. from Colorado College in 1965 and a B.F.A. and M.F.A. from the Yale University School of Art and Architecture in 1968. Jane Boyden operates a private music studio near Albuquerque, New Mexico, where she teaches piano and composition. She received a B.A. from Colorado College in 1965 and a M.A. from Yale University in 1968.
